



University of Lincoln Students' Union COVID-19 Engine Shed Entry Policy

Introduction

The ULSU COVID-19 Entry Policy takes into consideration the safety of all persons within LSUT venues, including customers and staff.

Following the Government's advice on the re-opening of venues and events, ULSU wants to help stop the spread of COVID-19 by implementing the use of the NHS COVID Pass.

Conditions of Entry

As a condition of entry, all customers, and any persons entering Engine Shed, will need to present a valid form of photo ID (eg: Driver's License) plus either

- proof of a negative lateral flow or PCR test taken within 48 hours of the event OR
- proof of double vaccination status

Either of the above criteria will be verified via, on the NHS app.

For double vaccinations, we will only accept the following forms:

- A valid NHS Covid Pass (via the NHS App)
- Proof via your NHA Vaccine Letter

For a negative lateral flow or PCR test taken within 48 hours of the event, we will only accept the following:

- A valid NHS Covid Pass (via the NHS App)
- Proof via email and/or text from the NHS dated within 48 hours of the event

Lack of Proof

Anyone who fails to present this proof will not be permitted to enter the venue and attend the event. No refunds will be offered in this case.

Venue Safety

Throughout the running of live events within the venue, we want all persons to feel safe and therefore the following measures are in place:

- Hand sanitiser stations will be situated throughout the venue
- Staff will continue to wear face-coverings
- The air ventilation system will be set at its highest capacity, replacing air from inside with air from outdoors, 12 times an hour
